



# Install Chrome as Your Browser

If you received your school computer and it doesn't have Chrome downloaded as your browser or default browser, follow these steps. You will need Chrome to fully access Google Classroom and Extensions that your teacher may ask you to use.

## Install Chrome

1. Download the installation file: <https://www.google.com/chrome/>
2. If prompted, click Run or Save.
3. If you chose Save, double-click the download to start installing.
4. Start Chrome:
  - Windows 10: A Chrome window opens after everything is done.
  - Because this is a school computer, you may receive a pop-up that tells you you need an administrator password. Just click "cancel" and you can continue to install Chrome.

## Make Chrome Your Default Browser:

1. On your computer, click the Start menu .
2. Click Settings .
3. Open your default apps:
  - **Original version:** Click System > Default apps.
  - **Creators Update:** Click Apps > Default apps.
4. At the bottom, under "Web browser," click your current browser (typically Microsoft Edge).
5. In the "Choose an app" window, click **Google Chrome**.

To easily open Chrome later, add a shortcut to your taskbar:

1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. In the Windows taskbar at the bottom, right-click on Chrome.
3. Click **Pin to taskbar**.
